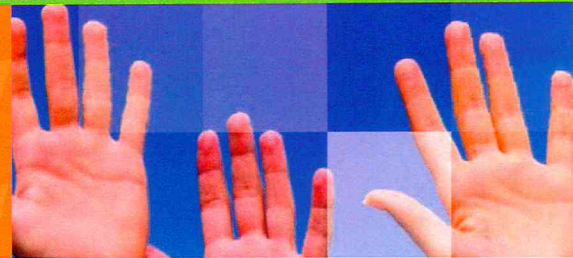

161 homes built or repaired in the U.S. and **25** internationally.

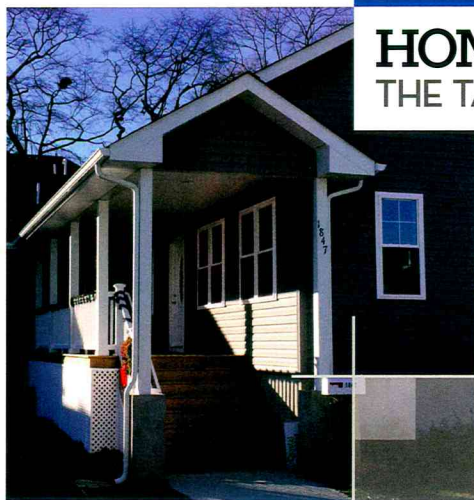
604 lives changed

THE TAYLOR FAMILY OF LAKE COMO

“IT’S DIFFICULT to describe what it’s like to leave your house one day and never be able to come back,” said Dawn Taylor, partner homeowner. “We lived in temporary housing for two and a half years before Coastal Habitat came into our lives. The volunteers rebuilt our home from the ground up like it was their own. I tell every volunteer that they are part of our family now. Life has begun again. THANK YOU.”

The Taylor home in Lake Como took approximately 9 months to design and build, utilizing the help of roughly 70 volunteers.

THE RESTORE THRIFT STORE runs on the energy of volunteers, selling lightly used and new, better-than-average furniture, housewares, home decor, appliances and electronics. Since it’s founding in 2007, the Asbury Park store has diverted more than 17 tons of potential waste from area landfills.

AFTER A YEAR OF PLANNING, in 2016, Coastal Habitat will introduce the ReStore Annex - a pop-up warehouse sale featuring select new and reclaimed construction supplies. One hundred percent of the proceeds from the ReStore stay local, helping to repair, rebuild and restore Southern Monmouth County.
